WHAT DOES PILGRIM BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and Income ■ Credit History and Credit Scores ■ Account Balances and Transaction History
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Pilgrim Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Pilgrim Bank, a state chartered cooperative bank, headquartered in Cohasset, MA.
What we do	
How does Pilgrim Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. Pilgrim Bank complies with federal and state information security requirements, including multi-factor authentication.
How does Pilgrim Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Open an Account or Apply for a Loan ■ Perform Transactions or Use Your Debit Card ■ Seek advice about investment or retirement plan options We also collect information from other companies, such as credit bureaus, to provide products and services to you.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. Please see MGL Chapter 93H, 201 CMR 17.00
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Pilgrim Bank will limit sharing information about a joint account when any one of the joint account owners Opts Out.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Pilgrim Bancshares, Inc., the parent company of Pilgrim Bank, a Maryland corporation incorporated in 2014 (OTC:PLRM)</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Plymouth Rock Financial Services, investment services by financial advisor located on Bank premises</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■
